people with disabilities.

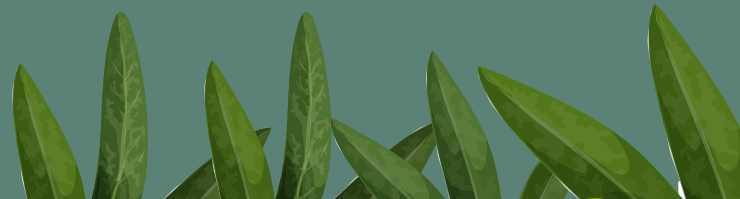
During the mobility a website
